The 11th Annual Open Net Ice Hockey Tournament, benefiting charities that address health-related issues and disabilities affecting children, is scheduled this year for Saturday, September 18, 2010, at the University of Delaware Ice Arena complex. Events for this year will include an 8-team adult tournament, a youth cross-ice tournament, family fun day activities and a silent auction featuring a wide range of gifts, household items, and sports memorabilia. This all-day event concludes with the championship game for the Open Net Trophy.

Our work fighting childhood diseases has been primarily focused on contributing to Juvenile Arthritis research at the A. I. DuPont Hospital for Children. In addition, we have contributed in smaller capacity to:

- American Lung Association, which helps children learn how to adapt to living with asthma

- UNICEF youth relief efforts in Haiti

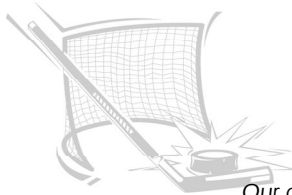

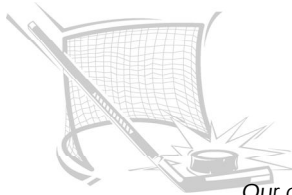
Tournament format:

The Open Net Foundation Over 30 Ice Hockey Tournament Rules

- Games consist of two twelve minute periods.
- Games are 4-on-4, plus goaltenders.
- "Open Net" means the last one minute of each game will be played without a goaltender.
- All "Open Net" goals must be scored on the attacking side of the blue line.
- If the game is tied at the end of regulation, there will be a four player shootout.
- Players must be 30 years of age or older
- All games will be completed by 5pm day of the tournament. Some teams exit early based on game outcomes but each team is guaranteed two games.

Penalties:

On all major penalties and/or misconducts, player(s) will be suspended for the remainder of the tournament. All minor penalties will be awarded a penalty shot. Any player on the ice at the time of the infraction may take the penalty shot. A player is only allowed one penalty shot per game. In the event all players on the ice have already taken a penalty shot, the team must select a player from the bench. A penalty shot is not awarded for coincidental penalties; players serve a one-minute penalty and the teams continue to play 4-on-4 hockey for the duration of the penalty.

The Open Net Foundation Cross Ice Hockey Tournament Rules

- Games consist of two twelve minute periods. Players will switch ends after the first period.
- There will be four teams with 8 players on each team. Every two minutes the horn will sound for a line change. Younger players (7's & 8's) will alternate with older players (9's & 10's).
- Gold, Silver, Bronze, and consolation medals will be awarded
- Games are 4-on-4, with NO goaltenders.
- Players not playing on the current shift will gather in the neutral zone while they wait for their next shift.
- No team entries. Players will be divided based on ability to make even team as best we can. Take the opportunity to make some new friends.
- Small nets will be utilized and a crease will be marked around each goal. No players are allowed in the crease from either team. If the referees determines that entering the crease impacted the play he has the option to whistle the play dead and call for a face off.
- All players will play two games. The winners of the first two games will play for the Gold medal. The losers of the first two games will play for the Bronze medal.

Title Sponsor - \$5,000
